

Where to Find Remote Jobs

You can find legitimate jobs on these sites that focus on remote work. Unless otherwise indicated, they don't charge job seekers. In addition to these sites geared specifically to remote jobs, the big job boards such as AARP's job board (jobs.aarp.org/), CareerBuilder.com, Glassdoor.com, Indeed.com, and Monster.com, are searchable for "remote" positions. Type in the word "remote" in the search box that asks for what job title you are looking for and you can drill down from there. On a recent visit to Monster, for example, more than 124,000 remote jobs popped up.

- **FlexJobs.com** includes remote work from home and other flexible jobs in over 50 career categories and ranging from entry-level to executive. A monthly subscription costs \$14.95.
- **Fiverr** (fiverr.com) has over 250 freelance categories.
- **Freelancer.com** connects employers and freelancers globally. Areas range from software development to writing, data entry and design to engineering, the sciences, sales and marketing, accounting and legal services.
- **Jobspresso.co** is a Canada-based site, frequented by U.S. workers, focused on remote jobs.
- **The National Telecommuting Institute** (ntiathome.org/), a nonprofit that works with the Social Security Administration to fill telecommuting jobs with people who have disabilities,
- **Ratracerebellion.com** has been at the forefront of the work-from-home revolution since 1999.
- **Remote.co**, founded by the woman who created FlexJobs, offers a great Q&A section to learn about leading remote-forward companies lists.
- **Sidehusl.com** is a user-friendly site that researches, reviews, and rates more than 300 online platforms geared to job opportunities. Hit what work you want to do, and it shows you the possibilities.
- **SkipTheDrive.com** is devoted to full- and part-time telecommuting jobs.
- **Toptal** (toptal.com) Toptal is a network of the top freelance software developers, designers, finance experts, product managers, and project managers from around the world.
- **UpWork** (upwork.com) has millions of jobs posting annually with seventy categories of work.
- **VirtualVocations.com** offers limited access to the site's job listings for free. Full access costs \$15.99 monthly.
- **Work At Home Vintage Experts** (wahve.com) is a contract staffing firm that places older professionals in work-from home jobs currently in the insurance, accounting, and human resource fields.
- **WeWorkRemotely.com** includes programming, sales, and other jobs.

- **Working Nomads** (Workingnomads.co/jobs) lists tech, management, marketing, and other jobs.
- **Ziprecruiter.com** lists over 8 million jobs, searchable by categories such as work from home, part-time remote, stay-at-home mom, work-from-home RN, and more.
